Gifts for your shoe box

TOYS: Soft toys, balls, building blocks, jigsaws, musical instruments, toy cars, dolls and jewellery

EDUCATIONAL ITEMS: Pens and pencils, pencil sharpener, rubber, colouring or puzzle books, notepad, pencil case, ruler, stickers etc.

PERSONAL ITEMS: Toothbrush and paste, hairbrush, comb, deodorant, shampoo, shower gel, sanitary items, soap, flannel etc.

FOOD: Dried foods like rice, lentils or pasta, biscuits (sweet or savoury), tins of beans, meat or fruit, coffee or tea.

OTHER ITEMS: Sweets, gloves, scarf, hat, ear muffs

IMPORTANT NOTE:
Please ensure all food has a use by date of at least 6 months



What to do!

1. Find an empty shoebox (any size), wrap the lid and box with wrapping paper
2. Decide if your box is to be for a boy or girl and what age group and write this on the box, or if your box is a food parcel for a family
3. Fill your box full of gifts and/or food, see the list of ideas below but also the No Thanks list
